Aromas of gooseberry and dried herbs lead into a fairly intense palate showing citrus fruits with a tangerine and citrus pith finish.	
Agerre Txakoli 2017, Getaria	27
A young wine with a long tradition. This delightful wine has a slight fizz for an ultra-refreshing finish. This natural spritz is heightened by the overhead pour.	
Vanidade Albariño 2017, Rias Baixas	29
Aromas of stone fruits and white flowers, crisp and refreshing. Perfect with anything fishy in a shell	
Bodega Pirineos Gewürztraminer 2017, Somontano	30
Bio-dynamically farmed Riesling and Viognier grapes grown high in the Catalan Pyrénées are vinified in stainless steel tanks and then the juice is aged on it's lees for over 14 months. The resulting wine has lip smacking	
Elle de Landaluce 2017, Rioja Alavesa	33
Pale gold in colour. Dry, with bright apple, peach and a hint of oak from 2 months in barrel. Classic blend of Viura and Malvasia.	
Joaquin Rebolledo Gocdello 2017, Valdeorras	36
From the granite and slate soils that border the river Sil in Galicia, this is wonderfully aromatic with peach, anise and ripe apple. Full and textured on the palate and a firm mineral finish.	
Biu de Sort Blanc 2015, Costers del Segre	41
Bio-dynamically farmed Riesling and Viognier grapes grown high in the Catalan Pyrénées are vinified in stainless steel tanks and then the juice is aged on it's lees for over 14 months. The resulting wine has lip smacking acidity with lots of lime and lemon and decent depth.	
Cerejeiras Reserva 2016, Obidos

Hailing from north of Lisbon in the cool and windy Lisboa wine region this is a blend of Chardonnay, Arinto and Vital. Almost Burgundian in style with aromatic complexity, ripe stone fruit and toasty vanilla notes all brought together with a silky texture.	

Trenzado 2016, Tenerife

A field blend of local varieties from the talented winemaking team at Suertes del Marques. Dry, lightly nutty, slightly oaky and all with an Atlantic tang.

Sameiras 1040 Colleita Blanco 2015, Ribeiro

51

Telmo Rodriguez sustainably produces this 100% Muscat from the hills just outside Malaga. Dry and intense with peach and honeysuckle notes and a long steely finish.

Cillar Blanco de Silos 2015, Ribera del Duero

52

A crisp and fresh style of Albillo fermented in stainless steel and then part aged in large oak barrels. Citrus and anise held together with mouth-watering acidity.

La Mar Terras Gauda 2015, Rias Baixas

59

85% Caino Bianco this wine has intense aromas of sweet hay and ripe tropical fruit. Textured on the palate with crunchy nectarine marked with ginger and balanced with fresh acidity.

Vermell 2016, Penedes

60

Intriguingly made from red zarel-lo, a rare indigenous Catalan variety that was saved from the brink of extinction. Delicate aromas of peaches and some soft red fruit and a long saline finish.

Planetes Blanca 2016, Priorat

71

A wonderful, rare 100% Carinyena Blanca, hand harvested and aged for 6 months in amphorae and then 3 months in French oak barrels. Fresh, with perfectly ripe white fruit and beautiful weight and texture.

Belondrade y Lurton 2016, Rueda

80

This 100% Verdejo created in the Burgundian style, is a benchmark wine for the Rueda. Ageing in barrel on it's lees for 10 months adds richness and depth which, along with the wine's fresh stone fruit and balanced acidity produces a true great.

Tears of Anima 2017, Peninsula de Setúbal

Made from 100% Sangiovese in the dry and fresh Provençal style. Aromas of

tangerine and plums and an excellent balance between the acidity and sweetness on the citrus and red fruit laden palate.

Hand-picked grapes from Landaluze's own vineyards with small production. This offers raspberry, blackcurrent and subtle cherry notes plus a suave undercurrent of vanilla.

A lighter bodied, mineral red with crunchy red fruits (redcurrant/cranberry) and refreshing acidity. Unoaked. This wine carries all the aromatic lift of the vineyards whence it comes

Here Juan Antonio Ponce has managed to master the difficult Bobal grape. Medium bodied with silky red fruit and a little gentle spice.				
Lo Petit de la Casa 2015, Priorat				40
A blend of 80% Garnacha, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon. Well-balanced and expressive with a smooth and structured finish. This represents outstanding value Priorat.				
Planella 2014, Montsant				42
Carinyena, Syrah and Garnacha grapes from over one hundred-year-old vines are grown following bio-dynamic practices and produce this wine bursting with fresh red berries, Asian spices, anise and a black pepper finish.				
Miros de Ribera Reserva 2012, Ribera del Duero				45
A wonderful example of what Ribera del Duero has to offer- black cherry fruit with silky fine tannins leaving rich smoke and black pepper flavours on the palate. Big aromatic bouquet and a hint of toasted wood.
